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To answer these questions we need to look to information within Intuit's 2024 Year-end Financials. And to answer # 1 and # 2 we need to answer # 3 and # 4 first:

"the new name (Global Business Solutions Group) better aligns with the global reach of the Mailchimp and QuickBooks platform, the company's focus on serving both small and mid-market businesses, and its vision to become the end-to-end platform that customers use to grow and run their business."





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Continuing to focus on # 3 and # 4, during Intuit's 4th-Quarter Investors Conference Call on August 22, Intuit's Chief Executive, Sasan Goodarzi, reported:

"In fiscal 2025, we are accelerating investments to better serve customers who have more complex needs, such as more sophisticated accounting and reporting requirements, business intelligence, money solutions, human capital management, professional services, and customer acquisition solutions with Mailchimp, all assisted by <u>AI-powered human experts</u>."





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Continuing to focus on # 3 and # 4, during Intuit's 4th-Quarter Investors Conference Call on August 22, Intuit's Chief Executive, Sasan Goodarzi, went on to say:

"Looking ahead, we are bringing QuickBooks and Mailchimp together to create a single growth platform, differentiated in the markets where we have product market fit...", "We are in a great position to win as an end-to-end platform...".

That's pretty clear. Mailchimp and QuickBooks Online (Advanced) Accounting including QuickBooks Live Assist, Payments, Payroll, and Capital, are targeted as a single AI-driven platform. Insightful Accountant

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Those two statements make it pretty clear.

"In fiscal 2025, we are accelerating investments to better serve customers who have more complex needs, such as more sophisticated accounting and reporting requirements, business intelligence, money solutions, human capital management, professional services, and customer acquisition solutions with Mailchimp, all assisted by <u>AI-powered human experts</u>."

"Looking ahead, we are bringing QuickBooks and Mailchimp together to create a single growth platform, differentiated in the markets where we have product market fit...", "We are in a great position to win as an end-to-end platform...".

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So, my answer for # 3 and # 4, in having seen so much Intuit evolution of:

QuickBooks Online (Advanced) Accounting including QuickBooks Live Assist coupled with Mailchimp, Payments, Payroll, and Capital, are all targeted as a single AI-driven platform.

Was fulfilled last Tuesday when Intuit announced "Intuit Enterprise Suite" the exact product made up of the above components that I had predicted.

So, QuickBooks Desktop is not the only change Intuit is making, QBO is 'evolving' too! (Murph)





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Speaking of QuickBooks Desktop, let's see if Intuit's financials give us a glimpse in questions # 1 and # 2...

"The company expects desktop ecosystem revenue to decline approximately 20 percent in the first quarter of fiscal 2025.... The first quarter desktop growth outlook reflects changes the company made to its QuickBooks desktop offerings in early fiscal 2024 to complete the transition to a recurring subscription model, including more frequent product updates. The company expects these changes to lower revenue in the first quarter of fiscal 2025 by approximately \$160 million..."

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- Will there even continue to be QuickBooks Desktop after September 30, 2025?

Speaking of QuickBooks Desktop, what's Intuit's financials saying about question # 1 and # 2:

"The company expects desktop ecosystem revenue to decline approximately 20 percent in the first quarter of fiscal 2025.... The first quarter desktop growth outlook reflects changes the company made to its QuickBooks desktop offerings in early fiscal 2024 to complete the transition to a recurring subscription model, including more frequent updates.

"The company expects these changes to lower revenue in the first quarter of fiscal 2025 by approximately \$160 million."

Since we know that Sales of Desktop Pro/Premier will end September 30th, and Intuit has only said that 'current subscribers' will be able to renew "the next time" their subscription is due (and their disclosure makes it pretty clear that they can change that policy at any time) the future of desktop is 'bleak' at best. Insightful Accountant

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What does all of this mumbo-jumbo mean, all this financial prognostication?

For Desktop, I'm afraid it's like a Dinosaur stuck in the tar pits.

The only question is how long before the struggling beast sinks into oblivion.

For Intuit's Cloud Accounting, looks like they are going for Mid-market with their new... Intuit Enterprise Suite, a nifty package aimed at providing everything for one bundled price.

For you and I, one or more 'alternatives' to Intuit might be our solution.





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When you consider alternatives, you have to consider 'what you are using now': Desktop Pro, Desktop Premier, Desktop Enterprise, QBO Simple-start, QBO-Essentials, QBO-Plus or QBO-Advanced.

If you are going to migrate from Desktop Pro, Desktop Premier, QBO Simple-start or QBO-Essentials you are probably looking at the same group of alternatives.

If you are going to migrate from Desktop Enterprise, QBO-Plus or QBO-Advanced, you are looking at probably another group of alternatives.





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If you are going to migrate from Desktop Pro, Desktop Premier, QBO Simple-start or QBO-Essentials you are probably looking at the same group of alternatives.





- Acumatica One of the simplest User-interfaces, reminds many users of QB; it has unlimited number of users built into the pricing structure. Many functional options depending on the nature of your business.
- Epicore Supports manufacturing, distribution, suppliers, retailers and other detail-oriented businesses with sophisticated analytics as well as core financials.
- Infor platform selection varies by business requirements, you need to understand what each platform offers specific to your business operations and needs. Platform may support construction, another platform supporting manufacturing, etc. Once configured provides great financial and analytic capabilities.





If you are going to migrate from Desktop Enterprise, QBO-Plus or QBO-Advanced, you are probably looking at one or more of these ERP solutions (along with others):

- Intuit Enterprise Suite Intuit's new all-in-one solution made of QuickBooks Online (Advanced)
 Accounting including QuickBooks Live Assist coupled with Mailchimp, Payments, Payroll, and
 Capital, all targeted as a single Al-driven platform to the Mid-market (Businesses \$3-M/year).
- Oracle NetSuite Perfect for growing companies, especially those operating on a global basis.
 Numerous turn-on features support cross-functional operations (like manufacturers with eCommerce sales, or wholesalers also operating retail, contractors serving as developers and homebuilders, etc.).
- MicroSoft Dynamics 365 if you are an 'everything Microsoft' company then this may be the right ERP solution for you. Offers functional support and features for most 'lines of business.'





If you are going to migrate from Desktop Enterprise, QBO-Plus or QBO-Advanced, you are probably looking at one or more of these ERP solutions (along with others):

- Sage Intacct great if you are running business segments like various S-corps clustered under a C-corp, or numerous C-corps under common (majority) ownership. Many features streamline and enhance GAAP compliant reporting.
- SysPro great for manufacturing businesses (with/wo direct sales) with personnel sophisticated
 to configure and run it. Typically, manufacturers looking for cost analysis of production operation,
 although operation time and payroll don't link-up.
- And maybe a couple of more thrown in for good measure!!!
